Sharing Jesus without Fear

During the last three years that we've been to Ukraine on Short Term Missions trips, God has been crafting a passion in us to equip Christians to share their faith in Jesus Christ.

This past year we could see this vision taking shape. In June 2003 we were able to teach the "Share Jesus Without Fear" seminar in twelve churches and several camps in Western Ukraine - all arranged through HART.

Approximately 600 people were in attendance at our seminars.

The "Share Jesus Without Fear" course makes you aware that, as a Christian, you need to be obedient to God in your Christian life, which

includes sharing your faith.

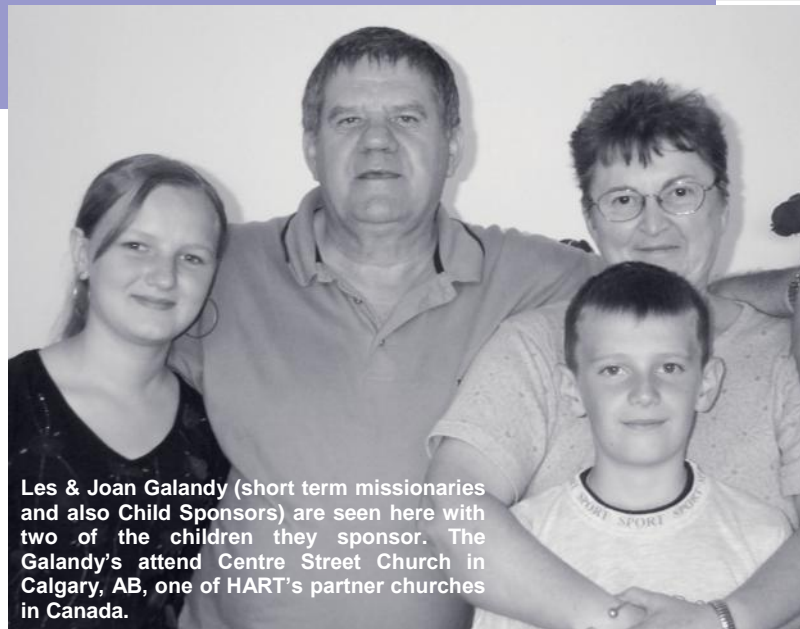
This course is a simple, easy-to-learn method of sharing one's faith, with no great Bible knowledge or debating skill needed.

It is a tremendous evangelistic "tool" for Ukrainian Christians.

This seminar is well received wherever it is presented with comments like, "I really needed to hear this to motivate me to talk to my friends about Christ." and "I wish I had know about this sooner, it seems so simple to talk to people about Christ."

God-willing, our plans this year would be to continue presenting the "Share Jesus" seminar to variety of churches in Ukraine.
